Child Welfare Policy And Procedures

Please read the following important information and complete the portion below:

• Child abuse is when a parent, caregiver, or another adult physically and/or psychologically mistreats a child causing injury or emotional damage to a child or youth. This includes physical abuse, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, as well as exposure to domestic violence. It can also result from a parent's or caregiver's failure to provide adequately for the child's basic needs (neglect).

• Every person who has reasonable grounds to suspect abuse of a child is required by the Child and Family Services Act to report as soon as possible to the Children's Aid Society. This duty cannot be relegated to anyone else.

• Confidentiality is critical, and information is not divulged to anyone except the properly designated school authorities.
